

Safety instructions:

These instructions are for adults to supervise children. Any reference to scissors, knives, matches and candles must be handled by the adult and kept out of reach of children. Do not leave children unsupervised with a lit pumpkin.

Scary Spider Lantern Instructions

You'll need :

- 1 medium sized pumpkin
(choose an edible pumpkin if you would like to make our 'Pumpkin and Chocolate Chip' recipe also available to download)
- A print out of page 3
- A pair of scissors
- Some sticky tape
- A pen
- A candle (tea lights are ideal, or a torch can be used)
- A sharp knife (or pumpkin carving kit)
- A large spoon
- A bowl

Step 1 - Make the Scary Spider Stencil

Print out the stencil on page 3 of this document. Cut out and remove the black section of the stencil. (Tip: Use a bit of sticky tape to keep your stencil together if you have cut from the outside edge of the paper).

Step 2 - Prepare the pumpkin

Start by just cutting off the top of the pumpkin. Do this carefully so you can put the top back on at the very end. Scoop out the flesh (keep the flesh in a bowl in the fridge should you wish to try our Pumpkin and Chocolate Chip Muffin recipe also available to download from www.fb.com/VictoriaChartCompany).

Step 3

Stick the stencil with a bit of sticky tape to the side of the pumpkin. With a pen draw on the pumpkin around the inside shape of the stencil (where the black used to be). Once done remove the stencil from the side of the pumpkin.

Step 4

Carefully cut out following the lines of the stencil to get your scary spider shape.

Step 5

Light up the pumpkin with a candle or a flashlight.

Step 6

Carefully put the lid back on the pumpkin. Place it in a sensible, stable place out of children's reach. Turn out the lights and enjoy your Scary Spider Lantern!
